**Re-Opening Discussion:** Decision regarding open camping will be on hold until the next meeting, July 12, 2020. We will continue with the previously proposed work parties, which was this; that any member or contracted staff must contact council (via Conney or Jef or organization email) regarding their intention. You must state the work intended and when you plan to arrive and leave. The maximum allowance per household to camp in the same circle is 6. There is no maximum overnight camp nights, but are based on the intended work. The member will be responded to with an acceptance or denial, and informed of the current procedures we have set forth. Noting: Radiance Hall is closed, as are the showers. Composting privies should be limited to one stall for said household, who will be responsible for personal cleaning before and after use, with cleaners we have supplied. If you must come through the gate, please clean the touched surfaces afterward. It’s recommended to clean/sanitize your hands before even touching the gate. Finally, all social distancing recommendations are to be followed. A work log can still be submitted to council via email, text, or, other options can be accepted.

**Review of (Virtual) Elf Fest:** Thanks to Jef and Pali for setting up the Facebook page allowing for a festival via social media. New posts have been disabled, but comments are still welcome. It was well received, and had many participants posting and commenting. It also spawned side groups for further online communication.

**Solstice Reunion:** Although the official fest is cancelled, there is discussion of having this fest virtual, as well. Pali will update us later.

**Priority Projects/Maintenance & Staff/Stewards working on the land:** Mowing and chainsaw work are the priorities for now. Some things can be done electronically, but if your contract is primarily on the land, please let us know when you are coming out to work. If you are unable or uncomfortable coming out to fill work hours, please inform us. There is no pressure for going down to work, but communication of your situation keeps us in the loop.

**Daniel Hartley’s cabin request final:** The motion on the screen (Pali) was to accept Daniel’s cabin proposal be built on the site formerly held by the Davies Clan on the North Rd. Furthermore, he will keep his frontage footprint within bounds, as to not overstep into the Labyrinth. Jack, first. In favor: 5; Opposed: 4. The motion passed. After, discussion was the possibility of creating a native plant bush row for separation. Daniel will make sure everyone knows the Labyrinth is open to all.
